- Good tech support



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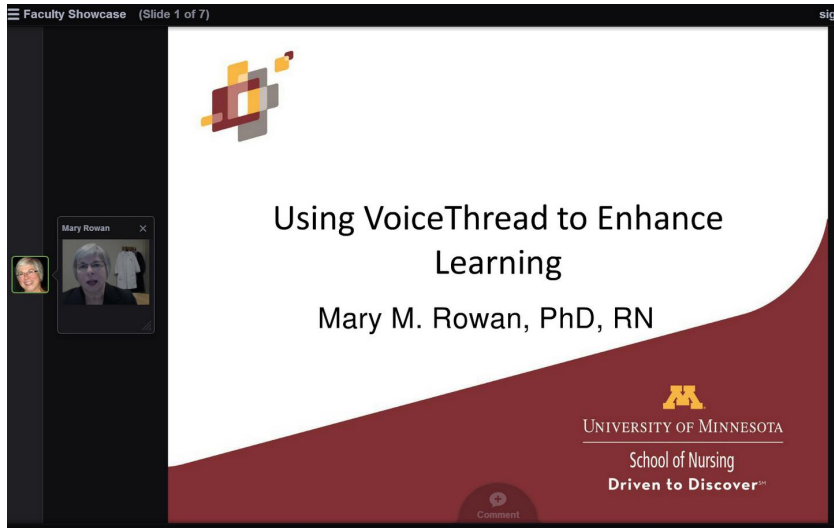

Narration: audio, video, text, captions

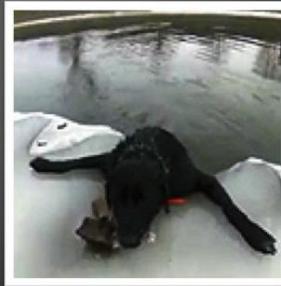
Can share presentation authoring or allow commenting.
