


## *Moodle Book Resource Tool*

<p><b>Which Principle(s) of Learning will this tool help address?</b></p>	<p>Organize Knowledge – the book Moodle Book Resource tool will allow you to organize content so to help students learn the content better. With the book tool you could organize the content in a way that is valid and provide rich connections between important and meaningful concepts, principles, etc.</p>
<p><b>What does it do?</b></p>	<p>The Book module makes it easy to create multi-page resources with a book-like format. The Book resource is essentially a multipage version of the Moodle Page resource type with the benefit of an Automatic table of contents, so using the book resource requires learning no new skills for you or your learners.</p>
<p><b>Show an example</b></p>	
<p><b>Why would an instructor want to use it?</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Book helps you organize your content into a book-like format that includes chapters, sub-chapters</li> <li>2. You could incorporate text, images, videos, podcast, interactive activities etc. into a book</li> <li>3. Book can be useful if you want to create review materials and/or reading assignments for your students.</li> </ol>
<p><b>What do you need to use this tool?</b> <i>(purchase software, download plugin, etc.)</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Book Resource is part of our Moodle Platform. To use the resource:</li> <li>2. Turn on Editing → Add activity or resource → select Book → Give your book a name → Look at other attributes to add (optional) → Click on “Save and Display” when you are done</li> <li>3. Start creating your first chapter</li> </ol>



<b>Pros/Cons</b> <i>(known issues)</i>	<p>Pro:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Organize materials on one area</li><li>• Ability to add multimedia into book</li><li>• Save space on main page</li><li>• Students can print chapter or book easily</li></ul> <p>Con:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Only can create chapter and sub-chapter (not any deeper)</li><li>• No way to tell of students read chapter or book chapter</li></ul>
